

Advisory Committee to the Treasurer

The Student Union Treasurer is the Chief Financial Officer of the Student Union. As the comptroller of all Union funds, s/he oversees and manages the entire money flow of over 1 million dollars of Student Activities Fee and other sources such as fundraising accounts of all Union Accredited Organizations (UAOs). In addition, s/he is responsible for setting the operations budget of the Union Government. The Treasurer also serves as a member of the Executive Board and an ex-officio member of the Finance Board.

During FY 2007 ~ 2008, members of Advisory Committee will meet the Treasurer on a bi-weekly basis.

The purpose of Advisory Committee to the Treasurer is to allow its members to get a chance to meet the Treasurer regularly and give recommendations, feedbacks, future references for changes, criticisms, and opinions on any finance-related matters.

Members

- Senate Chair of Club Support Committee of the Student Union Senate
- 1 member from secured organization
- 2 members from chartered organizations
- 1 member from recognized organization

By majority vote, the members of the committee will elect a Chair of the Committee, who shall be responsible for the conduct and operations of the committee.

Roles of Advisory Committee

Advisory Committee will act simply as a group of advisors. The committee does not have any decision-making authority.
