We have received a case submission for Petitioner Maizlish. The Clerk of the Court is in receipt of this case. The UJ has now reviewed both the petition, and a brief of opposition from the respondent's counsel.

After many hours of deliberation (this is written in the 6<sup>th</sup>), a Justice of the Court has granted certiorari to claims #2 and #3 in the case submission. However, claim #1 was not granted cert, as the proper respondent is not Student Union Secretary Michael Goldman.

The constitution states that the case shall be heard within five academic days of its presentation to the Clerk of the Court, contingent upon certiorari, unless both parties agree to a date after this period. As such, please contact the Clerk of the Court to arrange a trial date and time. Please note that this Thursday is not an academic day. Also, both Thursday and Fridays may be considered holidays by certain involved parties. The Union Judiciary strongly recommends that we hold these hearings next Sunday, per our availabilities.

We will establish our standing rules of order for the proceedings, and inform both parties of these prior to the hearing of the case. We will attempt to release these procedures by midnight Tuesday. In the meantime, please attempt to coordinate a date and time for the hearings with the Clerk.
